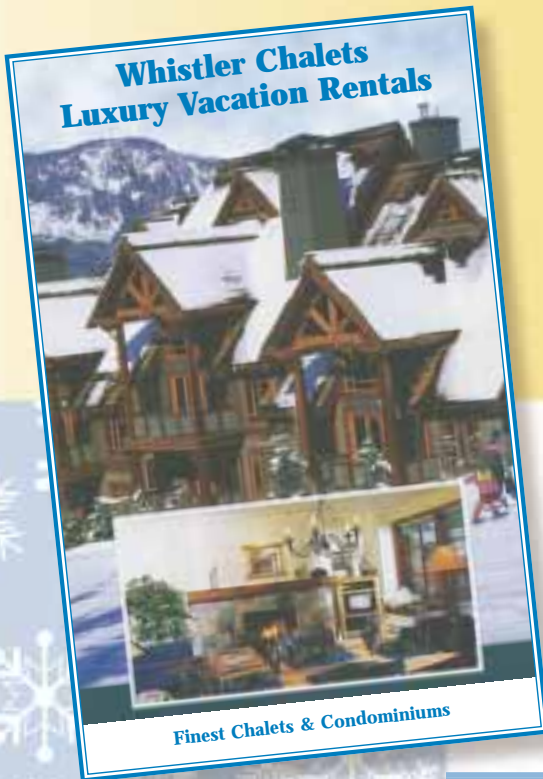


Welcome to Whistler/Blackcomb



If you have skied Whistler, then I don't have to tell you about this place. In every one of the surveys of skiers and ski instructors, comparing all of the ski resorts in North America, Whistler/Blackcomb has been rated **first** for the past six years. This magnificent resort is owned by IntraWest Corporation, also rated the **number one** ski management company on the continent.

There are actually two ski mountains, and in the middle is Whistler Village, a quaint collection of excellent restaurants, shops, and other services for skiers.



If you like numbers, Whistler has:

- 5,150 feet X2 mountains of vertical, the tallest ski mountains on the continent.
- 7,071 acres of skiable terrain, the most in North America
- 13 high speed lifts; 32 in the system, virtually 0 line-ups.
- #1 Rated Ski Resort in America, 6 years in a row.
- The best exchange rate in 140 years (\$1 US = \$1.50 Canadian).

Schedule:

We meet at San Francisco Airport. We travel as a group, non-stop to Vancouver, Canada. We have rented ski vans waiting, and will drive to Whistler, move into our rooms, and get a full night's sleep (if we can!).

In the morning we breakfast, load skis on vans and drive five-ten minutes to the slopes. For the next four days, we ski, ski, ski! Many of us will join the complimentary Mountain Ski Tours; some will take lessons; many will just ski. Most of us meet for a quick lunch; some will eat on the slopes! Generally, we ski in small groups, at different skill levels, gathering and not, as the fancy strikes. There will be fantastic skiing for beginners and experts and all levels in between.

At the end of the day, we go home for a soak in the hot tub, before dinner, a group event. Evenings are spent around the fireplace, with wild tales of daring, sharing the whirls and thrills of a mix of extraordinary lifetimes. Some may opt to walk around Whistler's beautiful village, sample the nightlife, or even retire early.

We are providing self-service breakfasts, lunch makings (or you can buy hot lunch on the slopes), and two group dinners. The third night, we will dine out, (not included in price) at one of the local hot spots. For insurance reasons, alcoholic beverages are not provided, so we ask that you BYOB.

The fourth day, we pack up in the morning before breakfast, ski until mid-afternoon, then grab our gear and head to the airport for an evening flight home. Total experience then, is four days skiing, four nights accommodations, ten meals, including all transportation and lift tickets
